



Power Treats - Switching formula . Daily maintenance diet for below mentioned and other similar sized birds to be combined with the maintenance or breeding food and as special treat for convalescent and weaning birds.

High Potency Coarse - Breeding formula is a daily maintenance diet with higher percentage of fat, protein, vitamins, and minerals for below mentioned and other similar sized birds which are breeding, moulting, or younger than 5 months and for familiarising below mentioned birds with the maintenance food. Start on High Potency 1 -2 months prior to breeding period to stimulate the breeding and increase the recommended volume of High potency by 1/3, double the amount of organic fruits and vegetables and for each 2 Tbsp add ½ Tbsp organic sunflower seeds. African Grey Parrots and Hyacinth Macaws should get the High Potency year -round.

Adult Lifetime Coarse / Adult Lifetime Pepper - Maintenance formula is a daily maintenance diet for below mentioned and other similar sized birds. For breeding and moulting birds, birds younger than 5 months, and African Grey Parrots and Hyacinth Macaws we recommend the High Potency food.

High Potency Fine / Super Fine / Mash - Breeding formula fine / super fine / mash is a daily maintenance diet with higher percentage of fat, protein, vitamins, and minerals for below mentioned and other similar sized birds which are breeding, moulting, or younger than 5 months and for familiarising below mentioned birds with the maintenance food. Start on High Potency 1 -2 months prior to breeding period to stimulate the breeding and increase the recommended volume of High potency by 1/3. Double the amount of organic fruits and vegetables in and for each 2 Tbs add ½ Tbs organic sunflower seeds (for small parakeets hulled and then chopped or ground).

Adult Lifetime Fine / Super Fine / Mash - Maintenance formula fine / super fine / mash is a daily maintenance diet for below mentioned and other similar sized birds. For breeding and moulting birds and birds younger than 5 months we recommend the High Potency Formula

*= Soak the formula in 2 Tbsp apple juice or Lori nectar. For Lories the Lori nectar should be offered as handfeeding formula in a mushy consistency.

Juvenile formula – Handfeeding formula: A nutritional hand raising diet for parrot chicks from their 21 day of age until weaning. It can also be used as digestive aid for fully grown birds.

Recovery Formula – Hand feeding formula: A nutritional hand raising diet for growth from hatchling to fledgling of small insectivorous birds with an apparent inability to digest cornstarch. For sick, injured or debilitated juvenile or adult parrots and other birds use as a gavage (by tube feeding) as well as supplement to support malnourished birds during diet conversion.

Neonate Formula – Hand feeding formula: A nutritional hand raising diet for parrot chicks in their first 3 -5 weeks of life or chicks of medium and large songbird species from hatching until weaning.

Bird Bread Mix : A premium, certified organic mix provides a healthy alternative for bird owners who choose to prepare their own bird food or those who give regular treats to their birds

HBD's Avian Enzyme : A source of live naturally -occurring enzymes for adult birds with incomplete digestion or hatched parrot chicks.

Hatched parrot chicks should receive lactobacilli cultures as a first diet app. 4 hours after hatching, followed by Neonate Formula for the next 3 -5 weeks. In their 4th and 5th week a gradual conversion to the Juvenile Formula should take place. Mix handfeeding formula with max. 50 Degrees Centigrade warm water and feed lukewarm (app. 41 Degrees Centigrade). It is recommended to add lactobacilli cultures and digestive enzymes (**HBD's Avian Enzyme**) to the ready -to-serve handfeeding formula. Repeat feeding only when crop is almost empty, gradually increasing the amount ! Chicks 1 -4 days old should be fed every 2 hours, elder chicks every 3 -4 hours with a longer break between 23:00 p.m. and 06:00 a.m. Chicks should be weighed in grams daily to assess steady gain.

Recovery Formula and Neonate Formula: Mix 1 part formula with 1 -2 parts water.

Juvenile formula: Mix 1 part formula with 2 -3 parts water.

Important feeding advice for all food types: Before any diet change consult with an avian veterinarian, Avifood or a qualified pet shop. Feed fresh food daily with separate access to water to prevent dunking. Supplementing with Vitamins or other bird food is not necessary or recommended. Because the food does not contain any artificial preservatives we suggest storing the opened food in the original, closed packaging in the refrigerator and to taste and smell it for freshness on a regular basis. When closing the package squeeze out air and seal bags with clips.
